The Behavior Technician will work directly under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst and will provide services within the client's home.

The focus of the job is to help the child/adolescent develop emotionally and behaviorally through the implementation of ABA-based approaches and behavior plans designed by the BCBA.

Behavior Technicians will record data after every session and report directly to their Program Supervisor.

Candidates must be able to work independently, be self-driven, and work in sometimes stressful environments.

- Will be subject to children with compromised immune issues, minor colds, sniffles, bloody noses, and gastrointestinal issues
- Clean nightly
